

In *Freedom But Not Really: The “Unprotected” Zones Of Article 19 (1) (A)*, the author states that there are nine grounds of challenge because he interprets that “decency or morality” as mentioned in Article 19(2) of the Constitution of India are actually two grounds. This has been supported by *Dr. Ramesh Yeshwant Prabhu vs Sri Prabhakar Kashinath Kunte & Ors* (1996 AIR 1113). However, the editors would like to clarify that in *Sbrey Singhal v. Union of India* [(2015) 5 SCC 1] it is held that there are only eight grounds of challenge.
